

## RCACA(C) Bursary Program

#### Introduction

The RCACA (C) Bursary Program will continue into the foreseeable future. Applications will be accepted commencing January 1 of each year, processing, and evaluation to be completed by March 31 and the applicants' Command Team notified thereafter.

#### Intent

The overall intent of the RCACA (C) Bursary Program is to support deserving applicants who are serving with the Corps by providing financial aid in their pursuit of a post-secondary education at the undergraduate, graduate, community college or vocational level leading to certification certificate, diploma or degree at an accredited post-secondary institution in Canada.

The Program intends to grant three gifts of \$1,000, \$1,500, and \$2,000 that will be awarded in the spring of each year to the top three eligible candidates based on based on weighted criteria.

#### Eligibility

Eligible applicants are:

- Applicants who are currently serving in RCAC units;
- Applicants who have been accepted into, or who are enrolled and continuing in, an accredited
  post-secondary institution in Canada, in a full or part-time program leading to a certificate, a
  diploma or a degree; and
- Applicants recommended and endorsed by their Chain of Command.

#### **Evaluation Criteria**

- 1. Service to Corps / Canada (Military and Civilian) (60%)
  - a. Awards and accomplishments (to include community service, decorations, and noteworthy efforts other than academic)
- 2. Academic Achievement (Military and Civilian) (30%)
  - a. Transcripts of civilian educational training (last 2 years);
  - b. Results and standings of applicant's formal military training; and
  - c. Academic awards and accomplishments.
- 3. Command Recommendations (10%)

#### **Application Process**

The applicant will complete and submit Annex A, as well as Parts I and II of Annex B, to their Chain of Command for review and confirmation. Part III of Annex B will be completed by the Chain of Command as indicated and signed off by the applicants' Commanding Officer.

Annex C provides further details on the processing and tracking of the application until the unit and the applicant have been made aware of the outcome.

We ask that the presentation of the bursaries be completed at unit level, and electronic photographs of the presentations are requested to be forwarded to the Association for website display and recognition to the President of the Association, LCol (Ret'd) Ross Wickware at: <a href="mailto:rosswickware@gmail.com">rosswickware@gmail.com</a>

#### **Application Deadline**

Completed applications must be received at the address indicated in Annex C no later than 31 March in each year.
